"Pests & Weeds Workshop".



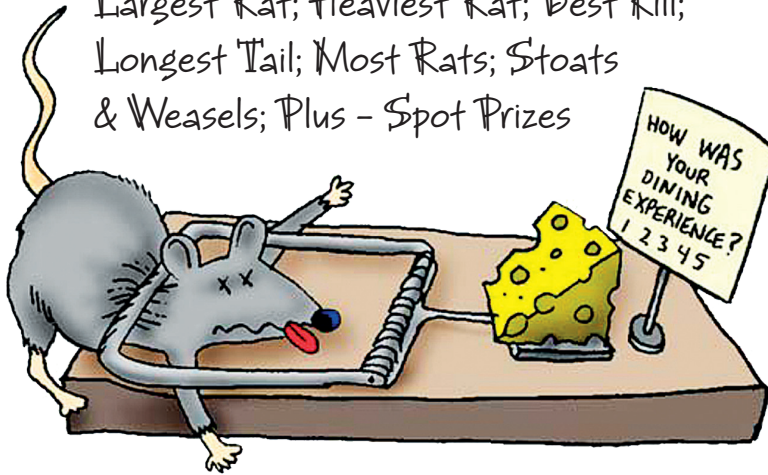
